The Criminal Justice Technology Specialist certificate is embedded within the Associate in Science degree in Criminal Justice Technology program. The Criminal Justice Technology Specialist certificate is designed to prepare individuals to work in law enforcement, corrections, private/industry security, and other criminal justice, legal, or public service related fields. The program prepares students to work as police officers and sheriff's deputies, correctional officers and jailers, and criminal justice practitioners/supervisors/managers in the various facets of the criminal justice system. It provides supplemental training for persons currently or previously employed in these occupations and may benefit professionals who are seeking incentive benefits or career enhancement in the field.

This is the sequence of courses for students interested in obtaining the Criminal Justice Technology Specialist college credit certificate. It does not represent a contract, nor does it guarantee course availability. Following this pathway will help you earn a college credit certificateⁱ.
